

Herbert F. Dohrmann

SEQUIM — Graveside services for Herbert F. Dohrmann, 80, of Diamond Point will be at 1 p.m. in Gardiner Cemetery. The Rev. John Morgan will officiate. Mr. Dohrmann died Sunday, June 1, 1997, in Sequim.

He was born Dec. 19, 1916, in Chicago to Herbert W. and Myrtle (Lindercamp) Dohrmann. He married Mildred Dieball on June 2, 1946, in Chicago.
