During World War II, he was also stationed on the new battleship *Massachusetts* for four years, during which he earned 14 battle stars and a citation from the ship's captain.

He was discharged from the Navy in 1947 as a chief petty officer.

Mr. Shannon married Nancy Jo Hanson in Issaquah on Dec. 11, 1946.

The Shannons settled in Seattle, where he completed millwork, cabinet and furniture making from Edison Technical.

In addition to buying and selling real estate, Mr. Shannon was the owner of Earth Services, Inc., an excavating company.

He was a member of the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association and Veterans of Foreign Wars.

Survivors include his wife of 60 years, daughter Jo Ann Dodaro of Sequim and two grandsons.
