

DAVE SWANSON

A graveside service for Dave Swanson, 74, of Diamond Point will be at 1 p.m. Saturday in the Gardiner Cemetery with members of Sequim Lodge 213, Free and Accepted Masons and Rhododendron Grange officiating. Mr. Swanson died Saturday in Diamond Point. Cremation was at Mount Angeles Memorial Park with Sequim Valley Chapel in charge of arrangements.

He was born Sept. 16; 1909, in Amukfors, Sweden, the son of Mauritz and Esther Svensson. He moved to Diamond Point 14 years ago from Edmonds. Mr. Swanson
