Land Use Permit Case #: Discovery Material LLC P.O. Box 68697 Seattle, WA 98168 (Applicant) has proposed a temporary use (ZON 2023-00015) on approximately 15 acres (APN 002332009 and 002332002) for a temporary use of a Concrete Batch Plant for the WA State Department of Transportation Fish Barrier Removal Projects along U.S. 101 within Clallam and Jefferson County. This is a Type I permit and is subject to SEPA, which

requires notice of application and comment period provisions of JCC 18.40.150 through 18.40.220

Description of Proposal: The applicant is proposed to locate a temporary concrete batch plant for approximately 3 years to have a close source of concrete for DOT fish barrier removal projects. Aggregate and cement will be brought to the site. The applicant would grade approximately couple thousand cubic yards of material to prepare a flat area for the concrete batch plant and truck loading areas. DCD will address stormwater requirements through the temporary use permit.

Location: This proposal is located approximal 0.5 miles east of Clallam County, and 0.25 miles north of U.S. 101 between Old Gardiner and Gardiner Beach Road (which would be utilized for access). The applicant owns 34.4 acres comprised of 4 parcels that was approved as a mineral extraction through ZON 2006-00038. This proposal would occur on the northern two parcels (APN 002332009 and 002332002).

Permits required: A Notice of Construction from the Olympic Region Clean Air Authority, and a NPDES General Sand and Gravel permit from the WA State Department of Ecology.

Reports Submitted: A Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) has been prepared for the proposal and will be utilized throughout the duration of the operation.

SEPA Threshold Determination: Jefferson County DCD is the lead agency for this proposal and has reviewed the proposed project for probable adverse environmental impacts and expects to issue a Determination of Non-Significance (DNS). The optional DNS process in WAC 197-11-355 is being used. This may be your only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposed project. Agencies, tribes, and the public are encouraged to review and comment on the proposal and its probable environmental impacts.

Comments must be submitted to the Department of Community Development by 4:30 p.m. on May 8, 2024.
